## 2020-2021 Scholarship Listing

The Elizabeth City State University (ECSU) Foundation, Incorporated is a public non-profit 501(c)3 entity. All scholarships held by the ECSU Foundation are made by donations from private gifts or grants. The ECSU Foundation awards all scholarships based on the donor criteria as stipulated in formal gift agreements.

1891 Scholarship	This fund shall provide undergraduate scholarships for full-time students. Entering freshmen must meet a weighted GPA of 2.5 or higher and at least 800 SAT (Critical Reading and Math only) or 17 ACT (Composite Score) Students who are recipients one year are eligible for consideration in any other year provided they continue to meet a cumulative GPA of 2.5, with award not to exceed four years. Preference should be given to need-based students who have declared a major. The value of this award shall not exceed the equivalent cost of that academic year's tuition and fees.
Agnes Whitfield Scholarship	Full-time student must be an athlete majoring in Education.
AKA Resource and Scholarship	The recipient is recommended by the graduate chapter of Alpha Kappa Alpha Sorority Incorporated.
AI Choudhury Memorial Scholarship	This scholarship fund shall provide a one-time scholarship of \$1,000 to one full-time undergraduate junior majoring in the Department of Mathematics and Computer Science or the Department of Natural Sciences majoring in Chemistry. Financial need and a GPA of at least 3.25 are required.
Athletic Director Scholarship	This fund shall provide scholarships to student athletes as set forth by ECSU Intercollegiate Athletics, CIAA and NCAA.
Athletic General Scholarship	Student athletes receiving these funds must have a 2.5 GPA or better, maintain enrollment as a full-time student, entering freshmen must have a minimum SAT of 950; ACT equivalent, maintain an overall 3.0 GPA after the freshman year to continue eligibility, apply funds directly to tuition and fees only and be a legal resident of North Carolina.

AW Thweatt Scholarship	This need-based scholarship is available to legal NC residents majoring in Biology, Health Sciences or Business Management with a GPA of 2.5 or better. Recipient must provide to the Office of Student Financial Aid and Scholarships a written acknowledgement to the donor prior to funds being released.
B Alex Scholarship	Only students enrolled at ECSU majoring in English and carrying a semester course load of a minimum of 12 credit hours are eligible for this scholarship, regardless of residency. It can be used to defray any costs associated with their educational program at ECSU.
BBT Scholarship	The individuals who are awarded this scholarship should be selected on the basis of a minimum SAT combined score of 800 and a GPA of 3.0 or better.
Bennie L. Williams Sr. Education Scholarship	This scholarship is available to full-time ECSU students majoring in Teacher Education. Student must have a 3.0 GPA or higher to continue eligibility. The scholarship is made available for incoming freshmen with a minimum entrance GPA of 2.8 and if they stay at the University for four consecutive years they must maintain a 3.0 or better GPA.
Benny O. Hodges Scholarship	Undergraduate scholarships for qualified student athletes at ECSU. Recipients shall demonstrate acceptable academic promise and shall have a record of good citizenship.
Bernice S. Ashe Scholarship	The student must be a resident of Northampton County or Hertford County, NC. This award is based on financial need for a student with a minimum GPA of 2.5 studying Education, Computer Science or Biology (Pre-Med.)
Business and Economics Scholarship	Awarded by the School of Business.
C. Peabody Davis Scholarship	Scholarship will provide a one-time scholarship for (1) one ECSU student each fall. The recipient must be a resident of North Carolina with first preference to Edgecombe County, second preference to Rocky Mount and third preference to Nash County. Student must be full time, have at least a 2.75 GA and be classified academically as a junior. The student must be admitted to the School of Education as an Education major.
Carolyn M C Ellis Scholarship	This scholarship is available to students with a minimum grade point average of 2.0. There is no academic major restriction or residency requirement for this scholarship.
CD Turnage Scholarship	This non-renewable, need-based scholarship is be awarded to ECSU students who are residents of NC or MD with a minimum high school GPA of 3.2. The student must be full-time, with a minimum SAT 880 or ACT 17 and major in Biology or Education.

Centura Bank Scholarship	The student must have completed the junior year; have a 3.0 cumulative GPA and 3.3 in major courses, have earned a minimum of 75 semester hours of which 30 are from ECSU and received a recommendation from the student's department head.
Charles Williams Scholarship	Recipients of this scholarship must have graduated high school in a college-preparatory program, had a 3.0 GPA or above, SAT 800 or above, been in the top 20% of graduating class and receive a recommendation from high school principal or guidance counselor and a community leader.
Charlie H & Louise Hughes Scholarship	Students who are NC residents, majoring in Elementary Education with at least a 3.0 GPA and carrying a semester course load of 12 hours are eligible for this scholarship.
Choir Scholarship	This scholarship may be awarded to incoming freshmen and current students enrolled in the University Choir with a minimum of 12 credit hours per semester. Student must maintain 3.00 or higher GPA, display a work ethic conducive for leadership and excellence.
Clark Scholarship	Leadership potential and the ability to give back to the university. The student must be involved in extra-curricular activities and be academically sound. Any gender or major may apply for this scholarship. The applicant must be committed to earning a baccalaureate degree from ECSU.
Class of 1966 Academic Scholarship	Scholarship is available to resident and non-resident students. Award must not exceed the equivalent cost of the academic year's tuition and fees, 2.5 GPA or better. First preference is for African American students as allowed by law.
Class of 1969 Scholarship	Full-time ECSU students.
Class of 1975 Scholarship	Current students enrolled at ECSU registered a minimum of 12 semester hours. 2.5 GPA minimum, maintain full time student status at ECSU. It is possible to retain scholarship (not to exceed 4 years) Funds maybe used to defray any costs associated with their educational program at ECSU. (e.g. tuition, books & other fees)
Class of 1979 Scholarship	Full-time ECSU students with a high school GPA of 2.5 or higher. Student must maintain an overall average of 2.5 to continue eligibility.
Class of 1980 Scholarship	This scholarship shall provide undergraduate scholarships. Students must demonstrate financial need and be a full-time student.
Class of 1981 Scholarship	This scholarship shall a one-time scholarship each fall to (2) two students who are in good academic standings. This scholarship is open to all majors. Additionally, the student must be enrolled full time, have a GPA of at least 2.75 and demonstrate financial need.
Class of 63 Scholarship	This scholarship is available to full-time students with a 2.5 minimum GPA and SAT score 800 or greater.

Class of 65 Scholarship	This scholarship is available to full-time student with a GPA of 2.0 or higher.
Class of 67 Scholarship	This scholarship shall provide \$500 annually for up to two (2) students meeting the following criteria: Incoming freshman must meet all admissions requirements; student must maintain an academic average of no less than 2.5 and student must demonstrate financial need.
Claude and Lois Green Scholarship	Full-time ECSU student who are legal residents of NC, minimum 850 SAT and 2.5 high school GPA, Maintain 2.5 GPA.
Cleveland A. Blount Jr Memorial Scholarship	This scholarship is an annual scholarship award that is selected by the Head Men's Basketball Coach. All students must meet the following criteria: Must have a 2.7 or higher GPA and be a member of the Men's Basketball Team.
CM Franklin Scholarship	Recipient must be a resident of NC, have a high school GPA of 2.5 or higher, be full time, have a minimum SAT score of 900 and maintain an overall GPA of 3.00 to continue eligibility. This is a need-based scholarship.
Cook Wood Scholarship	Full-time ECSU students.
D Jenkins & C Jenkins Scholarship	This scholarship is available to ECSU students who are members of Alpha Kappa Alpha Sorority, Inc., have at least a 3.0 GPA and maintain full- time status
Delta Sigma Theta - Alumnae Chapter Scholarship	This fund shall provide a \$500 scholarship to one full time ECSU student who is a member of Delta Chi Chapter of Delta Sigma Theta Sorority, Inc. The student must be in good academic standings with a 3.0 or above GPA, be academically classified as a junior (no seniors) and have documented leadership and community service.
Dr. Angelou Foundation Scholarship	This fund provides one general scholarship and one scholarship to a physically-challenged or mobility- impaired or re-entry student.
Dr. Brian R. Copeland Scholarship	This scholarship supports students from New York with preference given to students from Brooklyn, NY. This scholarship fund is available to education and science education majors with a minimum GPA of 3.0. The recipient will receive an annual scholarship of \$2,500.00. The scholarship is non-renewable. Sophomores, juniors and seniors with a minimum course load of 16 hours are eligible for this scholarship.
Dr. Donald Golden Brandon & Bernice Bias Brandon Scholarship	This scholarship is available to ECSU juniors that are Education majors with preference given to those in the area of Elementary Education k-6. The award recipient should be from the state of Maryland and have at least a 2.7 GPA. The recipient is required to keep the donor informed of their academic progress.

Dr. Naginder S. Dhillon Scholarship	This fund will be utilized to support ECSU students who intend to pursue graduate studies in political science and law. These funds can be awarded to defray any costs associated with their graduate application process including testing fees, application fees, travel to and from prospective graduate school and tuition fees and books. Student applicants must possess and maintain a 3.0 GPA.
E. Kirk Rivers Endowed Scholarship	This scholarship is available to Northeastern High School graduates who live in the fourth ward of Elizabeth City, NC. The applicant must complete an application, write an essay and provide a copy of the letter of admissions in the application packet. Three letters of recommendation should accompany each application. Applicants for this award must possess a demonstrable record of leadership in the church, school and community.
Eason Athletic Scholarship Fund	Scholarship fund shall provide an annual scholarship to full time students of Elizabeth City State University, qualified student athletes in the ECSU Football program with a 2.7 GPA, and recipients shall demonstrate acceptable academic promise and shall have a record of good citizenship. This scholarship is presented in the student's Freshman year.
EC Payton Mills Scholarship	This scholarship is available to ECSU students who are residents of Pitt County with 750 SAT score.
ECSU National Alumni Association Endowed Scholarship	Recipient must carry a minimum course load of 12 credit hours with a 3.0 GPA.
ECSU Orchestra Scholarship	Current students enrolled at ECSU registered a minimum of 12 semester hours. 2.5 GPA minimum, music major with violin, viola, cell or double bass as primary instrument, enrolled in MUS 260, Orchestra for every semester the scholarship is granted.
ECSU Retirees Association Scholarship	Students must be NC residents, new freshmen, enrolled in not less than 15 semester hours, per semester, have a cumulative GPA of not less than 3.00 and meet all ECSU entrance requirements.

ECSU Wachovia Pharmacy Program	<p>Applicant must be incoming ECSU Freshmen interested in working towards admission into the UNC Chapel Hill/ECSU Doctor of Pharmacy Partnership Program. Any student academic deviation from the pre-pharmacy requirements could result in revocation of the scholarship award. Ideal applicant would have participated in the Wachovia Pharmacy Fellows Summer Program. Ideal applicant has completed 80 or more documented hours of pharmacy internship work under the direct supervision of a registered pharmacist. Scholarship applicants must have a cumulative high school or equivalent GPA of at least 3.0 or above. Undergraduate award recipient should maintain a cumulative GPA of at least 3.5, maintain the required relationship with their assigned pre-pharmacy academic advisor, and avoid academic deviation from the pre-pharmacy requirements to maintain their award each semester. When applicable, PharmD students must maintain an overall GPA of at least 3.0. Preference will be given to students from the 21-County ECSU service area. All applicants must apply, be admitted, or enrolled full-time at ECSU to be eligible. The post graduate service award requires that applicants be prior scholarship recipients, registered pharmacists in NC and provide a signed letter from a pharmacist employer in the 21 -county area.</p>
Eley-Sengupta Mathematics Educational Scholarship	<p>Undergraduate scholarships for full-time, NC resident students in good academic standings (3.0 GPA), junior or senior, Mathematic majors in the department of Mathematics and Computer Science or Math Education majors in the Department of Education, Psychology, Physical Education.</p>
Ella Baker Scholarship	<p>The scholarship is available to full-time students with a minimum GPA of 2.0, minimum SAT score of 800, majoring in any field of study and from the New York geographical area..</p>
EN Smith Scholarship	<p>This need-based scholarship is available to undergraduate students majoring in Health and Physical Education or in the Department of Business and Economics. Recipient must be a member of Delta Sigma Theta or Alpha Phi Alpha. The recipient must be a full-time student and maintain a 3.0 GPA.</p>
EVOLVE with GRACE Scholarship Fund	<p>This scholarship fund shall provide a scholarship to full time students who are male, a graduate of Halifax or Northampton County Schools, Maximum GPA of 2.4-2.9, be at least a junior and declare a major in Business or Sociology.</p>

Ferebee Scholarship	This fund shall provide undergraduate scholarships. Students must be a graduate of Camden, Currituck, Gates, Pasquotank or Perquimans county, demonstrate financial need, be committed to earn a baccalaureate degree from Elizabeth City State University and carrying a semester course load of a minimum of 12 credit hours, have and maintain a grade point average of at least 2.5. The scholarship award will be apart of recipients Financial Aid package that is presented to them, and if they remain at the University, will be eligible to retain this scholarship throughout their tenure as a student (not to exceed four years) as long as they continue to meet the scholarship criteria. Funds can be used to defray any costs associated with the student's educational program at ECSU. This would include tuition, books and other fees.
First Floor Scholarship	Only students enrolled at Elizabeth City State University , with a declared major in Business Administration, carrying semester course load of minimum of 12 credit hours, and maintaining a minimum of GPA of 3.0 are eligible for this scholarship.
Flora Bryant Brown History Scholarship	This scholarship shall provide two \$200 scholarships on a yearly basis. One undergraduate student in good standing at ECSU with a minimum cumulative GPA of 3.0 majoring in History and One accepted incoming transfer or freshman student with a high school or transfer GPA of at least 3.0 was declared a History major.
Floyd Robinson Scholarship	ECSU student must be an instrumental music major in good standing, preference will be given to percussionist and double reed majors. Student must pass an audition conducted by Floyd Robinson or his designee. Student must have three letters of reference--one from high school band director. An applicant to be considered for additional awards after freshman year, the applicant must maintain a B or better GPA in Applied Music, be recommended by the Applied Music Instructor and be enrolled and in good academic standing.
Franklin and Hannah Owens Scholarship	This scholarship is open to full-time students in good standing with the university who are in the University Choir or major in the School of Education and Psychology.
FUMC Music Scholarship	Scholarship provides for 6 students. Awarded to all US resident students with any major that are participants in the ECSU University Choir. The scholarship is a one time award open to all students that meet the following criteria: Must have a GPA of 2.85 & above (3.0 and above is preferred). Must be able to read music; attend all services between Sept 1 - May 15 of each academic year; must have music learned prior to rehearsals; and must understand that failure to meet the terms and conditions may result in the revocation of the scholarship.

General Scholarships	General Guidelines*
Gilchrist Scholarship	Any gender or major may apply for this scholarship. Student must exhibit leadership potential and have the ability to give back to the University. Recipients must be full time and involved in extra-curricular activities but not limited to campus activities. The recipient must be academically sound with a minimum high school GPA of 2.5.
Glaxo Foundation Scholarship	This fund provides scholarships to full-time, women students. Each fall this fund provides scholarships to two students. Students must have a GPA of 3.0 or better. The student's GPA must remain 3.0 or better to be eligible to continue receiving the award.
Greg Russell and Mail Boxes, Etc Scholarship	Awarded to a student in the Elizabeth City State University Aviation Program, for an incoming freshman who had a 3.0 or better high school grade point average. Priority for awarding this scholarship will given to students who come from eastern North Carolina, which for this purposes of this award, is defined as anyone who lives in the area east of Interstate Highway 95. If they stay at the University for four consecutive years, they will be eligible to retain this scholarship throughout their time as a student (not to exceed four years). It can be used to defray any costs associated with their educational program at ECSU. This would include tuition, books and all other fees.
Hawkins and Heyward Scholarship	More than one student may be eligible for this scholarship every year. Only students from Northampton County (NC) enrolled at Elizabeth City State University and carrying a semester course load of a minimum of 12 credit hours and a minimum GPA of 2.5 are eligible for this scholarship.
Health PE Scholarship	Students must be a physical education major; must have a C average
Henry N and Alice C Tisdale Scholarship	This renewable scholarship is to support pre-majors or majors in Middle Grades 6-9 Education in the School of Education. The recipients shall be in good academic standing as defined by ECSU and shall demonstrate good academic standing by maintaining a GPA of at least 2.5. First preference to African American students as allowed by law.
Honors Program Scholarship	Current students enrolled in the ECSU Honors Program registered a minimum of 12 semester hours. 3.0. GPA minimum, (minimum for Honors Program) HP students may use funds for travel, presenting research, or needs as designated by donor. Funds may be used to defray any costs associated with HP educational enterprise, which includes tuition, books, travel ,lodging, sustenance and all other fees.



Horne Costen Boyce Scholarship	Students must be active members of the Men's or Women's Basketball Teams who meet the following criteria: legal resident of NC, high school GPA of 2.0 or higher, full-time student, minimum SAT score of 800 for entering freshmen, maintain a 2.00 GPA and demonstrate need.
Howell Family Scholarship	Recipients must be rising sophomores or juniors, have a current and overall GPA of 3.0 or higher, be from Bertie, Carteret, Durham, Edgecombe, Martin or Wake counties, be a member of the Pre-Alumni Club, reside on campus, be a full-time student whose major is Computer Science, Business Administration or Criminal Justice. To apply, a student must submit a completed application, photograph and one page essay that is post-marked by the deadline.
Insurance Scholarship	This merit-based scholarship is for students accepted into the Walter R. Davis School of Business with a minimum GPA of 2.5, NC resident, demonstrated commitment towards a degree in Business Administration. Student must be accepted in the School of Business & Economics
J S and Carrie Roebuck Scholarship	This scholarship provides football scholarships to athletes residing in Camden, Chowan, Currituck, Dare Pasquotank and Perquimans counties.
JE Cofield Scholarship	The recipient of this award must be a full-time student with a major in Education. The student must be a junior or above with a GPA of no less than 2.5. The student must be an active participant in the university life with demonstrated leadership and good character.
Jenkins Scholarship	Recipients of this scholarship must be a NC resident, have a high school GPA of 2.5 or higher, be full time, SAT of 850, maintain a 2.5 GPA and demonstrate need.
Joe White Scholarship	The award shall be given annually to any sophomore who meets the following criteria: 2.5 GPA, financial need, has shown the most progress within his/her freshman class, participates in an extra-curricular activity and majors in Industrial Arts or Technology.
Johnson & Barnes Scholarship	This scholarship is available to incoming freshmen enrolled at ECSU from the 21-county service area of NENC and carrying a semester course load of a minimum of 15 credit hours. The student must major in Social Work or Business Administration, be active in the community and become a member of the Pre-Alumni Club. The student must maintain a 2.5 GPA.

Johnson & Johnson Scholarship	The criteria preference for this scholarship of \$1,000 per student during the Honors Program each spring semester are as follows: one student must be an African American senior mathematics major with the highest GPA above 3.00 and one student must be an African American senior elementary education major with the highest GPA above 3.00 in attendance at ECSU for three consecutive years.
Joyce and Justine Long Legacy Scholarship	This scholarship shall provide a \$1,000 scholarship per academic year to an ECSU student. Recipients shall be in good academic standing as defined by ECSU and demonstrate financial need. First recipient shall be pursuing a degree in Education. The second recipient may be from any field of study.
JT Jackson Scholarship	Ones student may be eligible for this scholarship that will be awarded at the Athletic Banquet every year. The award recipient must be a full-time academically eligible football player.
Kevin Wade Scholarship	Only the current Mr. and Miss ECSU are eligible for this scholarship. The scholarships will be presented annually during the Mr. and Miss. ECSU Coronation. Mr. and Miss ECSU must keep the donor abreast of his/her academic progress throughout the matriculation of their reign, and Mr. and Miss Elizabeth City State University will submit a written summary of activities and the information to be forwarded to the donor at the end of each semester.
Kirby Scholarship and Talent Grant	This is a merit scholarship has first preference of two students based on their academic performance and two students based on their athletic or other talents (such as band, choir, student leadership or other extra-curricular activities.) This fund shall provide four scholarships in the amount of \$500
LaTanya Afolayan Endowed Scholarship	This scholarship is open to any undergraduate who demonstrates a commitment to his/her academic goals and community service. This is a recurring scholarship for sophomores, juniors and seniors. Each recipient must possess a 2.5 GPA and be a full-time student. The preferred majors are Education, Music, Business, Visual Arts, Political Science, English and Communication Studies. The recipient must complete 10 hours of community service monthly at one of the following entities--elementary schools, hospital, food bank, nursing home, homeless shelter or animal shelter. Community service can be combined between agencies.

Leonard Ballou Memorial Scholarship	Recipients must be rising juniors or seniors majoring in History or Political Science, enrolled in a minimum of 12 semester hours, have a 3.0 GPA or higher in major, write a 250 word essay to apply and have two letters of recommendation from the faculty.
Linda Davenport-Sanders Scholarship	The student must be enrolled in the ECSU Marching Band and the Concert Band.
Lucy Wright Lewis Memorial Scholarship	Recipient shall be enrolled at ECSU and have at least 2.5 GPA. Total awards may not exceed \$5,000. This is not a recurring scholarship. A new recipient should be selected each year. Freshmen are eligible. Recipient may not be immediate family of the donor. A thank you note to the donor must be sent to the Office of Financial Aid and Scholarships before this scholarship can be awarded.
Margaret and Lorimer Midgett Scholarship	This scholarship is available to ECSU students from Pasquotank, Camden, Currituck and Dare counties, North Carolina.
Margie and Calvin Griffin Scholarship	Recipient shall be an undergraduate, full-time student, resident of Camden, Pasquotank, Currituck County (NC), Chesapeake, VA or Prince George County, MD. Recipient shall be in good academic standings as defined by ECSU. Shall demonstrate Financial need. Award shall not exceed the equivalent cost of that academic year's tuition and fees. A student who is a recipient on year is eligible for consideration in any other year provided they continue to meet the selection criteria.

Marvin and Lois Thornton Scholarship	<p>The recipient(s) may be freshman or returning students, shall be in good standing as defined by ECSU, shall demonstrate financial need, shall demonstrate good moral character and involvement in extracurricular activities, work outside of school and/or community service by submission of at least two letters of recommendation to the Office. Students who are recipients one year are eligible for consideration in any other year provided they continue to meet the selection criteria outlined above. First preference shall be for members of Mt. Carmel Missionary Baptist Church (836 Hwy, 158 W. Elizabeth City, NC 27909), if no members of Mt. Carmel Baptist apply, or are otherwise qualified for this scholarship. Second preference shall be for residents of Pasquotank, NC, if no resident from Pasquotank County, NC applies or is otherwise qualified for this scholarship then, Third preference shall be for members of Pilgrim's Way Baptist Bible Church (6501 Parsons Avenue, Baltimore, MD 21215. If no person from the above named areas apply or are under consideration in any year then awards shall be give to ECSU students who otherwise qualify under this agreement.</p>
Mary Douglas Endowed Scholarship	<p>This fund shall provide one (1)* annual scholarship in the amount of \$1,000 to a full-time, undergraduate student at ECSU in good academic standings.</p>
Mary E Powell Scholarship	<p>This fund shall provide undergraduate scholarships for full-time students as follows: Elementary education majors; first preference shall be for residents of the following areas: Virginia Counties: James City, York, Isle of Wight, Gloucester or Mathews; Virginia Cities: Virginia Beach, Norfolk, Chesapeake, Newport News, Hampton, Portsmouth, Suffolk, Williamsburg or Poquoson: North Carolina Counties: Currituck or Gates. Second preference shall be for residents of the state of Virginia. Recipients shall have and maintain a GPA of 3.0 or better. This scholarship shall be limited to a single student demonstrating financial need until such time as the fund can support additional awards. (Renewable)</p>
Mary E. Sharpe Scholarship	<p>This recurring scholarship is available to full-time undergraduate students who are NC residents, major in Elementary Education, be in good academic standings, be classified as a junior and maintain at least a 3.2 GPA.</p>
Mary Hyatt Scholarship	<p>This scholarship is available to full-time ECSU students with a minimum GPA of 2.0 and a minimum SAT score of 800. The scholarship is open to any major for students from New York and New Jersey.</p>

Mary Tillery Scholarship	This need-based scholarship is awarded to sophomores, juniors or seniors who have demonstrated a sincere desire to complete a four year academic program.
Math and Computer Science Scholarship	This scholarship may be awarded to a full-time student with a major in Math and Computer Science, with an overall GPA of at least 3.00 and a GPA of at least 3.50 in Math and Computer Science major courses. Student must display a work ethic conducive for academic excellence and leadership. Student must be in good academic standing and must maintain the highest moral and ethical standards and be free of criminal charges and convictions and free of infractions against school policies and procedures. If a full-time student is not eligible, a part-time student that meets the preceding criteria may receive the scholarship.
Math Science & Technology Merit Scholarship	Entering Freshmen must have a 3.75 GPA with 28 ACT/1240 SAT or 3.5 GPA with 30 ACT/1320 SAT and express an interest in a major in the School of Math, Science and Technology. This award is renewable annually for full-time students for a maximum of 3 years, provided the recipient maintains a 3.5 or higher GPA and continues to pursue a degree within the School of Math, Science and Technology. Recipients must maintain the highest moral and ethical standards and be free of criminal charges and convictions and free of infractions against school policies and procedures.
Matthew and Christine Lewis Scholarship	Only students enrolled at Elizabeth City State University and carrying a semester course load of a minimum of 12 credit hours are eligible for this scholarship. Eligible enrolled students may be incoming freshman or upperclassmen. In addition, eligible students must meet the following criteria, reside in or record Martin County, Pitt County, or Hertford County as their home county, register with the Scholl of Education and Psychology as at least of one of their major courses of study, and maintain a minimum grade point average of 2.5 in high school or college.
Maurice Powers Scholarship	This scholarship shall provide funding for any students who demonstrate considerable financial need and who are likely to make a strong, positive impact in the school community and in their chosen field. Scholarships of up to \$4,000 annually will be awarded to students who do not have the funds available to pay the financial gap due to their unmet need. Students must be pre-major or major in the Department of Natural Sciences, Pharmacy and Health Professions, be in good academic standings as defined by ECSU, be full-time and first preference is to award one female and one male up to \$2,000 each not to exceed \$4,000 annually.

Mickey Burnim Scholarship	Applicants must commit to major in Business, Economics, Teacher Education or a science discipline, have a minimum cumulative high school GPA of at least 3.0 (B), have a minimum SAT score of 1,000 and be committed to earning their first baccalaureate degree from ECSU. A continuing student must have at least a 3.0 GPA
Myron Burney Memorial Scholarship	This fund shall provide a one-time scholarship for one student each fall. The student must be full time, have a GPA of at least 2.5 and demonstrate financial need. First preference goes to students that are from Columbus County, NC ( Cities included: Whiteville, Chadbourn, Cerro Gordo, Evergreen, Hallsboro, Lake Waccamaw, Bolton, Tabor City and Fair Bluff). Second preference goes to students majoring in English.
Myrtle G. Boone Endowed Scholarship	Only students enrolled at Elizabeth City State University and carrying a semester course load of a minimum of 12 credit hours are eligible for this scholarship. The purpose of this fund is to support costs of textbooks for students at ECSU.
NC Legislative Black Caucus Scholarship	Recipients of this scholarship must have a 3.0 GPA or higher. Freshmen, sophomores, juniors and non-traditional students are eligible. Students must complete the foundation application form and submit it with their essay to the Financial Aid Office. A report from the institution identifying scholarship recipients along with a professional photograph of each student, classification, hometown, major, academic average and scholarship amounts awarded along with copies of essays should be returned to the foundation by the end of each semester.
Norman Buster Murphy Scholarship	One scholarship each shall be a North Carolina resident from Bladen and Sampson County. First preference, African American as allowed by law, Native American, as allowed by law, a minimum GPA of 3.0, recipients shall demonstrate financial need. Pre-majors or majors in the Department of Business, Music, English, and/or Science, Qualified applicants may be recipients of other scholarships. Awarded funds may be used for tuition/and or other costs exceeding tuition necessary for the student to attend the University. If no applicants meet the criteria during a given year, funds will be held until the following year or until an acceptable applicant qualifies.
Nucor Fellows Program and Scholarship	All Nucor scholarships will be awarded to students who are residents of the following NC counties: Hertford, Bertie, Gates, Pasquotank, Northampton, Chowan and Perquimans. Only students with a minimum GPA of 3.0 are eligible.
Omega Psi Phi - Scholarship	This scholarship is available to full-time ECSU students who are members or relative of Omega Psi Phi Fraternity.

Partway Home GAP Fund Scholarship	Fund shall provide renewable scholarships up to \$350 per semester to returning students. Additionally returning student must have 90+ earned credit hours, be in good academic standing as defined by ECSU, demonstrate good academic standing by maintaining a 2.0 GPA and complete degree within 18 months.
Paul & Patricia Norman Scholarship	This fund shall provide a one-time scholarship for one full-time ECSU student from Bertie, Washington or Wake County, NC, have a GPA of 2.5 and demonstrate financial need.
Peterson Scholarship	Current students enrolled at ECSU registered a minimum of 12 semester hours. 3.5 GPA minimum, theatre major classes, and be in good standing with ECSU
Phillip Smith III Scholarship	This scholarship will award \$500 to two full-time students from Hampton or Newport News, Virginia.
Pitt Scholarship	Recipient of this scholarship must be a full-time student, a citizen of Edgecombe County, NC, complete a scholarship application, be ranked in the top 25% of their high school graduating class, have a high school gap of 3.0 and SAT score of 1100.
Pre-Alumni Club Scholarship	This fund shall provide undergraduate scholarships for full-time students. Student must be a member of the Pre-Alumni Club. Student must have a cumulative GPA of 3.0 or higher. The value of this award shall not exceed the equivalent cost of that academic year's tuition and fees. A student who is a recipient one year is eligible for consideration in any other year provided they continue to meet the selection criteria outlined in this Agreement.
Richard Reid Scholarship	This \$1,000 scholarship will be awarded to a business major with a minimum GPA of 2.0 each year. The scholarship will be awarded to a sophomore, junior or senior at ECSU.
Ridley Scholarship	This scholarship is available to students with a GPA of 2.0. The student must display leadership qualities. Using 100 as a basis, 65 points shall go to University Center Activity and 35 for other campus activities. This award comes with a plaque that shall be displayed on the wall of the Ridley Center.

RL Vaughan Scholarship	First preference shall be residents of the Tidewater region of Virginia and/or the state of North Carolina. Recipients shall demonstrate good academic standing by maintaining a GPA of 2.5 or the minimum required by the University and/or Athletics Department, whichever is higher. The student must be majoring in Physical Education. The recipient shall demonstrate a financial need. This scholarship shall be limited to a single student demonstrating financial need. The value of this award shall not exceed the equivalent cost of the academic year's tuition and fees. Students must be full time. A student who is a recipient one year is eligible for consideration in any other year provided they continue to meet the selectin criteria outlined in this Agreement.
Robert E. Harvey Scholarship	This fund shall provide one scholarship in the amount of \$1,000 or two \$500 scholarships. The student must be an undergraduate, resident of Delaware, New Jersey or Pennsylvania, in good academic standings with a 2.5 or higher and demonstrate financial need.
Ruth Holley Frinks Scholarship	This fund shall provide income to support a one-time scholarship for one student at ECSU each fall. Additionally, student must be a resident of Chowan County, NC, be a full time undergraduate student with at least a 2.5 GPA and major in Education with first preference being Elementary Education.
Saunders Scholarship of Excellence	Full-time, undergraduate, good academic standings with a minimum 3.0 cumulative GPA, need-based and successfully completed 30 credit hours.
School of Education Merit Scholarship Fund	Entering Freshmen must have a 3.75 GPA with 28 ACT/1240 SAT or 3.5 GPA with 30 ACT/1320 SAT and express an interest in a major in the School of Education and Psychology. This award is renewable annually for full-time students for a maximum of 3 years, provided the recipient maintains a 3.5 or higher GPA and continues to pursue a degree within the School of Education and Psychology. Recipients must maintain the highest moral and ethical standards and be free of criminal charges and convictions and free of infractions against school policies and procedures.
Sharonda C. Walton Scholarship	Recipients must be a resident of Northampton County, major in Computer Science, have a high school GPA of 2.5 or no less than the minimum set by the UNC System and must have a SAT score of 800 or no less than the minimum set by the UNC System.
Sheryl Denise Ganus Scholarship	Students majoring in Computer Science with at least a 2.8 GPA and carrying a semester course load of 12 hours are eligible for this scholarship.



Social Science Justice Scholarship	Recipients must have completed three semesters of General Studies and major in History. Scholarship will be announced each year at the Honors Convocation.
State Employees Combined Campaign Scholarship	Recipients must be a NC resident with a grade point average of 2.5 or higher, be full-time, with a minimum SAT score of 750 or minimum set by UNC System. Returning students should have a GPA of 2.5 or higher.
TH Wamack Award	The scholarship will be awarded to a junior or senior who is majoring in one of the Social Sciences. The award will recognize academic progress, potential for success, the overall involvement of a student in the Social Sciences and the university and community in general. A certificate or plaque shall accompany the award.
The Delta Chi Chapter Scholarship	This scholarship fund shall provide \$500 a year to full-time students (at least 15 hours) that is a current member of Delta Chi Chapter of Delta Sigma Theta Sorority, Inc. and have at least a 3.0 GPA.
The ECSU Geology Scholarship	This scholarship supports three students each year. Students must be full time Geology majors and have a GPA of 3.0 or better.
The ECSU Scholarship Fund	Must be an ECSU student.
Thorpe Athletic Scholarship	This fund shall provide annual scholarships in the amount of \$500 for undergraduate student athletes who are residents of NC, in good academic and athletic standings as defined by ECSU, full-time and maintain a GPA of 3.25 or better.
Thorpe Aviation Scholarship	This fund shall provide annual scholarships in the amount of \$500 for undergraduate students who are residents of NC, in good academic standings as defined by ECSU, full-time, maintain a GPA of 3.25 or better and declare a major in the School/Department of Aviation Science.
Trustee Emeriti Scholarship	Only students enrolled at Elizabeth City State University and carrying a semester course load of a minimum of 12 credit hours are eligible for this scholarship. It can be used to defray any costs associated with their educational program at ECSU. This would include tuition, books, and all other fees.
Viking Varsity Scholarship	This scholarship is used to attract and retain top student athletes coming out of high school and entering ECSU. The student must carry a semester course load of at least twelve hours.
Vivian Burke Scholarship	This fund was established at ECSU in 1982 to fund scholarships for students from the Northeast Ward of Winston-Salem, NC. This scholarship may not be renewed. It is to be dispersed in the amount of \$1,000 every other year to full-time students taking at least 15 hours. The student must be an incoming freshmen.

Vivian S. Perrimon Scholarship	This fund shall provide a scholarship in the amount of \$500 each year to one (1) full time ECSU student that meets the following criteria: Be in good academic standings, maintain at least a 3.0 GPA (unweighted), be a member of the Pre-Alumni Club, demonstrate financial need, maintain full time enrollment and consideration will first be given to students from the states of Georgia, Alabama, Texas, Florida and Louisiana.
Watts Scholarship	More than one student may be eligible for this scholarship every year. This scholarship is awarded to students from Craven County with a minimum grade point average of 2.5. The scholarship recipients must major in on of the following areas - Education, Aviation, Science and Music Industry Studies, Only students enrolled at Elizabeth City State University and carrying a semester course load of a minimum of 12 credit hours are eligible for this scholarship,
Wayland H Cato Jr Endowed Scholarship	Students carrying a semester course load of a minimum of 12 credit hours, demonstrate a financial need, shows evidence of having demonstrated a commitment to strong work ethic through meaningful work experience in the public or private sector and a commitment to volunteerism through performing meaningful community service without compensation. This scholarship is renewable.
WC Witherspoon Endowed Scholarship	The recipient must be a graduating senior from Pasquotank, Perquimans, Currituck, Camden or Gates County and must demonstrate financial need. Only students enrolled at ECSU and carrying a semester course load of a minimum of 12 credit hours are eligible for this scholarship.
William "Steve" Settle Memorial Scholarship	NC Resident students enrolled full-time majoring in the department of Business & Economics, good academic standings, need-based. <b>The recipient will write a thank you note to the donor and provide it to the Office of Financial Aid and Scholarships prior to the award being released.</b>
Willie Mae Jones Johnson Scholarship	Recipients of this need-base scholarship must meet the following criteria: legal resident of any state, 2.5 or higher GPA, full-time student and have a minimum SAT of 850 or 750 for entering freshmen.
Winifred J. Wood Scholarship	This renewable scholarship is available to residents of Camden, Gates, Pasquotank or Perquimans counties, NC. Students qualifying for this scholarship must have a minimum 3.0 CGPA coming out of high school.

Youth Education Scholarship	Recipients shall have a cumulative GPA of at least 2.5, demonstrate strong financial need and exemplify qualities of leadership and community service. Preference shall be given to Sociology, Finance, Education or Business Administration majors. If the scholarship committee cannot find a student that meets the criteria, the committee may select any student from the state of NC.
